It is the policy of the School District to require an acknowledgement of risk as a condition of participating in this program. If your student would like to participate, please carefully read and sign this document. Those students that do not participate will not be permitted to drive off campus during the lunch period.

This program includes driving without supervision during the school day AND/OR being a passenger in a vehicle driven without supervision during the school day. I, the undersigned parent, hereby acknowledge and understand that, regardless of all feasible supervision and safety measures that may be taken by the district, participation in this program entails certain inherent risks. I certify that my student has an insured vehicle, valid driver's license, and my permission to leave campus. I certify that my student is allowed to be in a vehicle with other students, and has my permission to leave campus. I further certify that my student will honor all policies of district staff and volunteers and failure to honor instructions may result in revocation of privileges. I agree to accept responsibility for my student's participation in the program. I understand any negligence arising out of the student's participation in the program shall be attributed to me as comparative negligence within the meaning of Section 27-1-702, MCA.
